SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 7

Relating to the Birchwood Loop Road and the Eagle River Road.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS in the Anchorage area the Birchwood Loop Road and Eagle River Road are, every day of the week, heavily traveled arteries; and

WHEREAS, in addition to the high volume of traffic, these are located in a densely populated area; and

WHEREAS these roads are currently in an unsafe condition, thus endangering the motoring public as well as pedestrians in the vicinity of the roads; and

WHEREAS the condition of these roads is such that with each passing day more deterioration occurs and these roads already are beyond the stage where they could simply be repaired;

BE IT RESOLVED by the Legislature that the Governor is respectfully requested to direct the Department of Highways to plan for the immediate reconstruction of the Birchwood Loop Road and the Eagle River Road by making their reconstruction a high priority.
