AN ACT

Relating to the concealment of merchandise.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 09.65 is amended by adding a new section to read:

Sec. 09.65.110. CIVIL LIABILITY FOR CONCEALMENT OF MERCHANDISE. A person who wilfully conceals goods or merchandise from a merchant's premises, in addition to any criminal penalty provided by law, is liable in a civil action to the merchant for damages of not less than \$100 or more than \$250, or in the case of goods or merchandise having a retail value in excess of \$250, for the full retail value of the goods or merchandise. In addition, the person violating this section is liable for all costs and reasonable attorney fees involved in the action.
