## AN ACT

Relating to the waste of wild food animals.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

\* Section 1. AS 16.30.010 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

(d) In this section, "most of the edible meat" of a wild food animal means no less than the meat of the front quarters, as far as the juncture of the humerus and the radius - ulna (knee), and the meat of the hind quarters, as far as the distal joint of the tibia - fibula (stifle joint) and that portion of the animal between the front and the hind quarters except the viscera and the meat of the ribs. However, the following is not considered edible meat:

- (1) the meat of the head and the neck;
- (2) any meat that has been damaged and made inedible by the method of taking; and
- (3) the bones, sinew, and incidental meat reasonably lost as a result of boning or a close trimming of the bones.
