## AN ACT

Relating to limited entry permits and interim-use permits for commercial fishing.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

\* Section 1. AS 16.43.170(b) is amended to read:

(b) Except as provided in (c) and (d) of this section, the holder of an entry permit may transfer his permit to another person or to the commission upon 60 days notice of intent to transfer under regulations adopted by the commission. No sooner than 60 days nor later than 12 months from the date of notice to the commission, the holder of an entry permit may transfer his permit. If the proposed transferee, other than the commission, can establish present ability to participate actively in the fishery, the commission shall approve the transfer and reissue the entry permit to the transferee.

\* Sec. 2. AS 16.43.220(b) is amended to read:

(b) The commission shall adopt regulations for the temporary transfer of interim-use permits to alleviate hardship. Interim-use permits are otherwise nontransferable.

\* Sec. 3. AS 16.43.260(a) is amended to read:

(a) The commission shall accept applications for entry permits only from applicants who have harvested fishery resources commercially while participating in the fishery as holders of gear licenses issued under AS 16.05.-536 - 16.05.670 before the qualification date established in (d) or (e) of this section.
