AN ACT

Prohibiting the misrepresentation of the condition of frozen meat, fish or poultry.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 45.50.471(a) is amended by adding a new paragraph to read:

(14) sell, falsely represent or advertise meat, fish or poultry which has been frozen as fresh food.

* Sec. 2. AS 45.50.561 is amended by adding a new paragraph to read:

(5) "fresh" means a condition of food which has never been frozen;

* Sec. 3. AS 03.05.010(f)(3) is amended to read:

(3) standards and labels pertaining to the sale of agricultural and vegetable seeds, meat, fish and poultry;

* Sec. 4. AS 03.05.010(f) is amended by adding a new paragraph to read:

(6) the examination and inspection of meat, fish and poultry advertised for sale or sold to the public.

* Sec. 5. AS 03.05 is amended by adding a new section to read:

Sec. 03.05.035. SALE AND LABELING OF FROZEN MEAT, FISH AND POULTRY. (a) Meat, fish or poultry which has been frozen may not be sold, represented or advertised as a fresh food.

(b) Meat, fish and poultry which has been frozen must be labeled as a frozen food, under regulations.

(c) The commissioner shall promulgate regulations which

(1) require frozen food labels for meat, fish and poultry which has been frozen; and

(2) provide for the examination and inspection of meat, fish and poultry to ascertain whether it has been frozen.
