AN ACT

Relating to the districts of the superior court.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 22.10.010 is amended to read:

Sec. 22.10.010. ESTABLISHMENT OF SUPERIOR COURT.
There shall be one superior court for the state. The court shall consist of four districts bounded as follows:

First District: the area within election districts numbered one to six, both inclusive, as said districts are described in art. XIV of the state constitution on March 19, 1959;

Second District: the area within election districts numbered 21 to 24, both inclusive, and those areas of election districts 18 and 20 within the boundaries of the North Slope Borough, as said districts are described in art. XIV of the state constitution on March 19, 1959;

Third District: the area within election districts numbered seven to 15, both inclusive, as said districts are described in art. XIV of the state constitution on March 19, 1959; and

Fourth District: the area within election districts numbered 16, 17 and 19, and the areas of election districts numbered 18 and 20 not included in the second district, as said districts are described in art. XIV of the state constitution on March 19, 1959.
