AN ACT

Relating to retroactive pay for state employees; and providing for an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. Each permanent and temporary state officer and employee shall receive a retroactive pay increase of six per cent of all gross wages earned by the officer or employee of the state during the period July 16, 1973, through January 15, 1974, or during any part of that period.

* Sec. 2. This Act does not apply to

(1) an employee of the division of marine transportation who is part of the exempt service as defined in AS 39.25.110(12);

(2) a certificated employee of the state-operated school system;

(3) a person who terminates employment with the state for any reason before February 19, 1974;

(4) persons elected to public office by popular vote or appointed to fill vacancies in elected office.

* Sec. 3. It is the intent of the legislature that the permanent employees of the legislative branch and the permanent and temporary employees of the judicial branch and the University of Alaska professional employees receive pay comparable to the pay received by permanent and temporary state officers and employees under sec. 1 and 2 of this Act.

* Sec. 4. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval or on the day it becomes law without approval.
