## AN ACT

Relating to early service credit under the public employees' retirement system; and providing for an effective date.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

\* Section 1. AS 39.35.360(a) is amended to read:

(a) An employee who completes three years of service with the state after January 1, 1961, for which he makes contributions required by this chapter is entitled to service credit for employment rendered to the State and former Territory of Alaska before January 1, 1961, regardless of the office, department, division, or agency of the state or territory in which he was employed, including service as a commissioned officer of the United States Public Health Service, the United States District Court and the United States Commissioner's Court serving the Territory and State of Alaska succeeded to by the Alaska court system, and persons employed as United States marshals, United States deputy marshals, and Civil Aeronautics Administration security guards. The retirement benefits payable to an employee under this section which are attributable to employment rendered to the State and former Territory of Alaska before January 1, 1961, shall be reduced by the amount of the retirement pension benefits paid to him by the United States government for the same period of prior service.

\* Sec. 2. AS 39.35.360(d) is repealed.

\* Sec. 3. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval or on the day it becomes law without approval.
