AN ACT

Requiring the transmission of criminal records and data to the offender's place of imprisonment.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 33.30 is amended by adding a new section to read:

Sec. 33.30.185. TRANSMISSION OF CRIMINAL RECORDS AND DATA TO PLACE OF IMPRISONMENT. (a) When a person is sentenced to imprisonment by a court for a criminal offense, copies of all reports, records, files or other relevant data on that person which may affect the person's rehabilitation shall be transmitted to the person in charge of the jail, penitentiary, or other prison facility in which he is confined.

(b) The commissioner shall adopt regulations providing controls and guidelines for the security, confidentiality and use of documents transmitted under (a) of this section.
