AN ACT

Expanding duties of Governor's Commission on the Administration of Justice.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 44.19.756 is amended to read:

Sec. 44.19.756. DUTIES OF STATE PLANNING AGENCY. (a) As the state planning agency, the commission has the responsibility of coordinating and planning in Alaska, the federal, state, and local efforts under Title I of the Omnibus Crime Control and Safe Streets Act of 1968, as amended.

(b) The commission is authorized to investigate state and local needs and seek funding for

(1) development of more effective crime prevention programs and techniques;

(2) development of programs to aid the courts in the field of criminal adjudication;

(3) development of programs to rehabilitate offenders and prevent recidivism.

(c) The commission shall assist the planning and coordination of criminal justice personnel in the Departments of Law, Health and Social Services, and Public Safety, the public defender's office, and other appropriate agencies in a manner which projects the necessary and advisable allocation, utilization, qualifications and coordination of criminal justice personnel at the state and local level.

(d) In order to facilitate interagency communication and cooperation, the commission shall hold interagency conferences for the discussion and planning of law enforce-

ment, crime prevention, criminal adjudication and offender rehabilitation programs and personnel for the Departments of Law, Health and Social Services, and Public Safety, the public defender's office and the court.
