BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 08.80.120 is amended to read:

Sec. 08.80.120. GRADING AND CONTENT OF EXAMINATION. To pass the state pharmacy examination each applicant must attain a general average of not less than 75 per cent and a grade of not less than 60 per cent in any one category of the National Association of Board of Pharmacy Standard Examinations for licensure or an equivalent examination given by the board.
