## AN ACT

Relating to death benefits under workmen's compensation; and providing for an effective date.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

\* Section 1. AS 23.30.215(a)(2) and (3) are repealed and re-enacted to read:

(2) if there is a surviving wife or dependent husband or a child or children of the deceased, the following percentages of the average weekly wages of the deceased:

(A) 60 per cent for the surviving wife or dependent husband with no children;

(B) 50 per cent for the surviving wife or dependent husband with one child and 20 per cent for the child;

(C) 50 per cent for the surviving wife or dependent husband with two children and 35 per cent divided equally among the children;

(D) 50 per cent for the surviving wife or dependent husband with three or more children and 40 per cent divided equally among the children;

(E) 30 per cent for an only child when there is no surviving wife or dependent husband;

(F) 25 per cent for each child if there are two children and no surviving wife or dependent husband;

(G) 66 per cent, divided equally, if there are three or more children and no surviving wife or dependent husband;

(3) if the surviving wife or dependent husband remarries, she or he is entitled to \$15,000 in one sum; however, total compensation may not exceed \$75,000;

\* Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval or on the day it becomes law without approval.
