## AN ACT

Relating to state aid to local governments; and providing for an effective date.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

\* Section 1. AS 43.18 is amended by adding a new section to read:

Sec. 43.18.012. AREA COST-OF-LIVING DIFFERENTIAL. (a) State payments to a city, organized borough or to an unorganized borough volunteer fire department under sec. 10 of this chapter shall reflect area cost-of-living differentials. Amounts distributed shall be based upon the sum of per capita, per mile and per bed or facility grants due each city or organized borough or volunteer fire department multiplied by the appropriate area cost-of-living differential. The area cost-of-living differential for each city and organized borough or volunteer fire department shall be determined annually by election district under the provisions of AS 39.27.030; however, the area cost-of-living differential to be applied shall not result in an amount to be distributed less than the base allocation.

(b) The election districts used in (a) of this section are those designated by the proclamation of reapportionment and redistricting of December 7, 1961, and retained for the house of representatives by proclamation of the governor September 3, 1965.

\* Sec. 2. This Act takes effect July 1, 1974.
