HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 104

Congratulating Mable R. Rasmussen upon being selected Alaskan Mother of the Year 1974.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS Mrs. Mable R. Rasmussen has made of motherhood more than just an incident, indeed a lifetime occupation; and

WHEREAS Mrs. Rasmussen and her husband, Harry, founded Hospitality House, a home for girls in Fairbanks, Alaska in 1957; and

WHEREAS she served with distinction as Administrator of Hospitality House until her retirement in 1973; and

WHEREAS during those 16 years Mrs. Rasmussen provided a mother's love and concern to hundreds of girls from every corner of Alaska; and

WHEREAS many of these girls are now mothers with a better chance of successfully raising their own children due to the guidance provided over the years by "Ma" Rasmussen; and

WHEREAS Mable Rasmussen has served as President of the Alaska Association of Child Caring Institutions for four years and was involved in drawing up standards of child care for Alaska; and

WHEREAS she has been active in setting up many programs for youth, particularly Native youth, and, in fact, has been made an honorary member of the Fairbanks Native Association;

BE IT RESOLVED by the Alaska State Legislature that it joins all Alaskans in commending Mable R. Rasmussen upon her accomplishments and congratulates her upon her selection as Alaskan Mother

of the Year 1974.
