## HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 35

Relating to visitor information centers.

\*\*\*\*\*

### BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS tourism is one of the state's major industries;  
and

WHEREAS throughout Alaska and at the principal transportation gateways and corridors to Alaska tourists and prospective visitors seek information about "The Great Land" that frequently outstrips the ability of the limited staff at visitor information centers to provide; and

WHEREAS, as the state develops its resources, the scope of information not only about travel to, but living in, Alaska that will be requested surely will expand markedly;

BE IT RESOLVED that the Alaska State Legislature respectfully requests the Governor to direct the Alaska travel division of the Department of Economic Development, working in concert with other appropriate state departments and agencies, to develop a plan for expanded state involvement in the visitor information centers both within the state and at the gateways to Alaska; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED that this plan, including but not limited to estimated costs and administrative structure, be submitted to the Legislature, if possible, during the Eighth Legislature, Second Session, by April 1, 1974, or to the Ninth Legislature by the fifth day of its First Session.
