## HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 65

Commending the Arctic Chamber Orchestra.

### BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS there exists in Fairbanks, Alaska a group of musicians known as the Arctic Chamber Orchestra; and

WHEREAS this group is dedicated to the playing of great concert music by Chopin, Mozart, Bach, Rossini, and many other renowned composers; and

WHEREAS performers give generously of their time and talent with no thought of monetary reward, indeed often at considerable personal sacrifice; and

WHEREAS the Arctic Chamber Orchestra, assisted by the Alaska State Council on the Arts, has performed in Palmer, Anchorage, Seward, Kenai, Homer, Kodiak, Hughes, Valdez, Cordova, Haines, Juneau, Petersburg, Wrangell, Ketchikan, Barrow, Kotzebue, Nome and Sitka as part of its traveling concert tours; and

WHEREAS the Arctic Chamber Orchestra has left a trail of cultural enrichment around our state, as well as exciting young musicians who otherwise would not have been exposed to live performances of great music;

BE IT RESOLVED by the Alaska State Legislature that it most sincerely commends Conductor Gordon Wright and each member of the Arctic Chamber Orchestra for their community spirit and their dedication to the arts in Alaska.
