HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 66

Relating to the naming of the new Kenai River Bridge currently under construction.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS Warren Ames has recently met an untimely death through drowning in the Kenai River; and

WHEREAS Warren Ames was raised on the banks of the Kenai and lived his life alongside this great green river; and

WHEREAS not only was Warren an accomplished artist and musician but typified the true Alaskan who loved, cherished and was completely devoted to Alaska and its heritage; and

WHEREAS the memory of Warren will long remain in the hearts of all Alaskans who were fortunate to cross paths with him during his brief sojourn in our midst; and

WHEREAS there is a new bridge under construction over the Kenai River which he loved so much; and

WHEREAS it would be most fitting and proper that this young and talented Alaskan, who served as an example of all that is good to Alaskans from all walks of life, be honored by having the new Kenai River Bridge named in his memory;

BE IT RESOLVED by the Alaska State Legislature that the Commissioner of Highways, upon completion of the new bridge over the Kenai, dedicate the bridge in honor of Warren Ames and name the bridge the Warren Ames Memorial Crossing.
