HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 76

Honoring Bernie Kosinski.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS longtime Alaskan, Bernie Kosinski, recently met an untimely death by drowning while attempting to aid his son; and

WHEREAS, at the time of his death, Bernie was General Manager of the ANCHORAGE TIMES and as such was known far and wide for his expertise in the business; and

WHEREAS an Alaskan by choice since 1943 he devoted his life to his family, community, and the Fourth Estate; and

WHEREAS in nearly thirty years with the TIMES he had served in the capacity of managing editor and executive editor, as well as that of general manager; and

WHEREAS Bernie Kosinski leaves behind a host of bereaved friends throughout this great state;

BE IT RESOLVED by the Alaska State Legislature that it expresses its most heartfelt sense of loss at the passing of Bernie Kosinski but is assured that the memory and works of Bernie Kosinski will long be remembered and that Alaska is today a better place to live because he passed this way.
