HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 83

Congratulating the Alaska Council on the Arts, Alaska Indian Arts, Inc., and Carl Heinmiller.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS Alaska Indian Arts, Inc. has been in existence since 1957; and

WHEREAS Alaska Indian Arts was organized to promote the restoration and revival of Alaska's Indian arts, crafts, and culture; and

WHEREAS Carl Heinmiller and the Alaska Council on the Arts have been instrumental in assuring the success of this program; and
