HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 87

Encouraging Alaska citizens' participation in the Fifth Annual Walk for Hope.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS Hope Cottage, Inc. is a home for Alaska's mentally handicapped citizens and provides an environment beneficial to the physical comfort and mental development of its residents by extending both the material and the intangible needs of the residents of Hope Cottage; and

WHEREAS monetary support is required to assure added expansion of existing programs and the initiation of new programs conducive to the well-being of those being cared for by the Cottage; and

WHEREAS Hope Foundation, Inc., for the second year, has united young Alaskans statewide in manifesting their support by pledging to participate in the Fifth Annual Walk for Hope;

BE IT RESOLVED by the Alaska State Legislature that by passage of this resolution it joins the Executive in urging all citizens of this great state to participate, thereby showing their concern for our less fortunate citizens, in the Fifth Annual Walk for Hope to be held on May 4, 1974.
