SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 24

Honoring Emery W. Chapple, Jr.

BE IT RESOLVED

BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS Emery Chapple has recently resigned from his state position as Commissioner of the Department of Public Safety; and

WHEREAS his departure from the department culminates almost 15 years of cumulative service as a peace officer in Alaska dating back to the commencement of his tenure as a member of the Territorial Police Force in 1954; and

WHEREAS the responsibility of being the man ultimately responsible for the safety and protection of thousands of Alaskans in an area the size of Alaska is so demanding that it is almost incomprehensible; and

WHEREAS Emery Chapple has carried out his duties with the greatest devotion and dedication to duty humanly possible with the continuing objective always being that of protecting the lives and property of Alaskans, as well as attempting always to emphasize the better aspects of human service;
