SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 54

Congratulating the Alaska physical fitness champions of 1973-74.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS thirteen students representing the Wrangell Institute have been declared the 1973-74 state champions for physical fitness; and

WHEREAS the students, in winning the title, all passed the national physical fitness tests which required them to score eighty-five per cent or more in each of seven events; and

WHEREAS the grueling tests consisted of sit-ups, pull ups, shuttle run, standing hand jump, softball throw, 50 yard dash and the 600 yard run; and

WHEREAS each student, in addition, had to attain specific levels of accomplishment according to their age level; and

WHEREAS this accomplishment of the Wrangell Institute students, culminating in the 1973-74 physical fitness championship for Alaska, stands as a feat that all Alaskans are proud to applaud;
