## SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 59

Relating to the inclusion of Lowell Point Road in the state highway system.

### BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS in 1972 the state spent the sum of \$54,000 to bring Lowell Point Road up to standard; and

WHEREAS, since the expenditure of those funds, the road has not been maintained and will rapidly deteriorate if it does not receive proper maintenance; and

WHEREAS the road is a continuation of the Seward-Anchorage Highway and is approximately a mile in length; and

WHEREAS the Caines Head State Park will be just south of the road and a proposed boat harbor will also very likely be constructed in the same area; and

WHEREAS the road traverses the beautiful Resurrection Bay area and is extremely heavily traveled and the traffic flow can only increase, and at a rapid pace;

BE IT RESOLVED by the Alaska State Legislature that the Governor is respectfully requested to direct the Department of Highways to include Lowell Point Road within the state highway system at the earliest possible time so that the road will receive proper care and maintenance at all times.
