SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 60

Honoring the New Archangel Dancers.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS the New Archangel Dancers of Sitka has grown from an original group of nine young housewives into three performing groups; and

WHEREAS these dedicated performers have, through their vivacious performance of authentic Russian folk dances, greatly aided in the preservation and perpetuation of the Russian culture which has played such a tremendous role in Alaska's history; and

WHEREAS the group has been praised widely by all who have had the privilege of witnessing one of their titillating shows, and visitors to our great state, as well as Alaskans, have commended the group as one of the most successful tourist attractions in the state; and

WHEREAS the troupe has performed at Alaska travel shows in Costa Mesa, California; Los Angeles, California; Seattle, Washington; Palo Alto, California; Portland, Oregon; Whitehorse, Yukon Territory and in every major community in Alaska; and

WHEREAS there are already one hundred shows planned for tour ship passengers during the summer of 1974;
