AN ACT

Creating the Goose Bay State Game Refuge; and providing for an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 16.20.030 is amended by adding new subsections to read:

(c) The presently owned state land, tideland, submerged tidelands, submerged land and water, and all those lands and waters acquired in the future by the state lying within the parcels described in (1) - (2) of this subsection are established as the Goose Bay State Game Refuge:

Meridian (1) Township 15 North, Range 3 West, Seward
Sections 17-20, 29, 30: All

Meridian (2) Township 15 North, Range 4 West, Seward

Section 1: W 1/2 W 1/2

Section 2-3: All

Section 4: Lot 1, SE 1/4 NE 1/4, E 1/2 SE 1/4

Section 9: Lot 1, 2, 3, NE 1/4 NE 1/4

Section 10-11: All

Section 12: S 1/2

Section 13-15: All

Section 23: N 1/2 NE 1/4

(d) The state may not acquire by eminent domain privately-owned land within state-owned lands specified in (c) of this section for inclusion in the Goose Bay State Game Refuge. The Department of Natural Resources may adopt, in accordance with the Administrative Procedure Act (AS 44.62), zoning regulations governing privately-owned land within the Goose Bay State Game Refuge.

(3) Egress and ingress to and from private property within the parcels described in (1) - (2) of this section shall be allowed through access corridor established through agreement between the Department of Natural Resources and the Department of Fish and Game, and with the private property owners involved.

* Sec. 2. This Act takes effect immediately in accordance with AS 01.10.070(c).
