AN ACT

Creating the Palmer Hay Flats State Game Refuge; and providing for an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 16.20 is amended by adding new sections to read:

Sec. 16.20.032. PALMER HAY FLATS STATE GAME REFUGE.

(a) The following state-owned lands and waters are established as the Palmer Hay Flats State Game Refuge:

- (1) Township 16 North, Range 1 West, Seward
Meridian
Section 1-12 inclusive
Section 13: N 1/2
Section 14-18 inclusive
- (2) Township 17 North, Range 1 West, Seward
Meridian
Section 25: All
Section 26: S 1/2, S 1/2 N 1/2, N 1/2
NE 1/4, NE 1/4 NW 1/4
Section 27: S 1/2, SE 1/4 NE 1/4
Section 31: Lot 4, SE 1/4, E 1/2 SW 1/4,
SE 1/4, NE 1/4, S 1/2 SW 1/4 NE 1/4
Section 32: S 1/2, S 1/2 NE 1/4, NE 1/4
NE 1/4, SE 1/4 NW 1/4
Section 33: All
Section 34: All
Section 35: All

- (3) Township 17 North, Range 1 East, Seward

(b) Selections under the Alaska Native Claims Settlement Act (PL 92203, 85 Stat. 688) are recognized as valid prior claims to the land within the area described in (a) of this section. Land specified in (a) of this section may not include land patented to a Native corporation under that Act.

(c) Land selected by the Matanuska-Susitna Borough in Township 17, North Range 1 East S.M. shall be included in the Palmer Hay Flats State Game Refuge, subject to borough approval. If the borough relinquishes the selection of these lands, the selected lands become part of the Palmer Hay Flats State Game Refuge.

(d) The state may not acquire by eminent domain privately-owned land within state-owned lands specified in (c) of this section for inclusion in the Palmer Hay Flats State Game Refuge. The Department of Natural Resources may adopt, in accordance with the Administrative Procedure Act (AS 44.62), zoning regulations governing privately-owned land within the Palmer Hay Flats State Game Refuge.

* Sec. 2. This Act takes effect immediately in accordance with AS 01.10.070(c).
