AN ACT

Relating to termination of membership on the Legislative Council, the Legislative Budget and Audit Committee or on a legislative interim committee.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 24.20.030 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

(b) When a member of the council files a declaration of candidacy for an elective office other than that of member of either house of the legislature, and he has not resigned from membership on the council, his council membership terminates on the date of filing.

* Sec. 2. AS 24.20.040 is amended to read:

Sec. 24.20.040. VACANCIES. When a vacancy occurs in the statutory or appointive membership of the council the presiding officer of the house incurring the vacancy shall fill the vacancy within 30 days. If the office of the president of the senate or speaker of the house of representatives becomes vacant and a vacancy occurs among the appointed members of the council, the remaining council members from the house incurring the vacancy shall appoint a new member. A legislator appointed to fill a vacancy shall be a member of the same political party as the member vacating the seat, when possible.

* Sec. 3. AS 24.20.171 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

(b) When a member of the committee files a declaration of candidacy for an elective office other than that of member of either house of the legislature, and he has not resigned from membership on the committee, his committee membership terminates on the date of filing.

* Sec. 4. AS 24.20.181 is amended to read:

Sec. 24.20.181. VACANCIES. When a vacancy occurs in the statutory or appointive membership of the committee, the presiding officer of the house incurring the vacancy shall choose a successor. If the office of the president of the senate or speaker of the house of representatives becomes vacant and a vacancy from the affected house occurs among the membership of the committee, the remaining committee members from the house incurring the vacancy shall appoint a new member.

* Sec. 5. AS 24.05 is amended by adding a new section to read:

Sec. 24.05.087. INTERIM COMMITTEE MEMBERSHIP; TERMINATION. When a member of the legislature who serves on a committee created during a between session interim by either house or its presiding officers, the Legislative Council or the Legislative Budget and Audit Committee, files a declaration of candidacy for an elective office other than that of member of either house of the legislature, and he has not resigned from membership on the interim committee, his interim committee membership terminates on the date of filing.
