## AN ACT

Relating to the Governor's Commission on the Administration of Justice.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

\* Section 1. AS 44.19.748 is amended to read:

Sec. 44.19.748. MEMBERSHIP OF THE COMMISSION. The commission is composed of 13 members, to include the following: the attorney general, the commissioner of public safety, the commissioner of health and social services, the chief justice of the supreme court, the public defender, one member from each house of the legislature, four other residents of the state chosen by the governor so as to give reasonable geographic and urban-rural balance, including representation from the major ethnic groups of the state, from units of local government and from other groups concerned with the administration of justice in the state, and two other residents of the state representing citizens and professional and community organizations related to delinquency prevention. Members serve at the pleasure of the governor.

Sec. 44.19.754. COMMISSION AS STATE PLANNING AGENCY. The commission shall act as the state planning agency under the Federal Omnibus Crime Control and Safe Streets Act of 1968, as amended, and the Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention Act of 1974, as amended.
