AN ACT

Relating to grants-in-aid for alcoholic rehabilitation and prevention.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 47.30.475(c) is amended to read:

(c) Grants shall be awarded in a ratio of 75 per cent state money to 25 per cent community money, except that in communities designated as poverty areas the ratio shall be 90 per cent state money to 10 per cent community money, for the purposes of providing staff and limited improvement, renovation or new construction of facilities for alcoholic detoxification, rehabilitation or "half-way house" care. No grant for improving, renovating or constructing may exceed \$50,000 except when there is a lack of applicants for available money and then only with the approval of the Advisory Board on Alcoholism. The department is not required to award all money available under this program, or the full percentages specified in this subsection, when another source of money is available or could reasonably be made available to the applicant.

* Sec. 2. AS 47.30.500 is amended by adding a new paragraph to read:

(4) "poverty area" means a district in which 15 per cent or more of the population, based on the 1970 census data, falls under 125 per cent of the Community Services Administration poverty guidelines.
