AN ACT

Relating to the operation of fishing gear.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 16.05.540 is amended to read:

Sec. 16.05.540. LIMITATION ON ISSUANCE OF FISHING GEAR LICENSES. The fishing gear licenses mentioned in secs. 550 - 650 of this chapter shall be issued one to the applicant. Each applicant shall personally operate or assist in the operation of the licensed fishing gear. "Operating or assisting in the operation of licensed fishing gear" means being present at the gear site and operating, assisting, or supervising the immediate fishing operation. Each applicant for the fishing gear licenses mentioned in secs. 570 and 580 of this chapter shall also personally own or lease the licensed fishing gear. The license is transferable as provided under sec. 670 of this chapter.

* Sec. 2. AS 16.05.670(e) is amended to read:

(e) It is unlawful for gear which is licensed as provided in this chapter to be operated or caused to be operated by a person other than the licensee or his assistant under the supervision of the licensee while the licensee is present at the gear site, or the person to whom the license was transferred or his assistant under the transferee's supervision while the transferee is present at the gear site, upon notice to the department.
