## AN ACT

Eliminating certain restrictions on the political activity of state employees; and providing for an effective date."

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

\* Section 1. AS 39.25.160(a) is repealed and re-enacted to read:

(a) An employee in the classified service or in those exempt positions named in sec. 110(3) of this chapter may be a member of a national, state, or local political party, may take part in a political campaign, and may exercise his right as a citizen to express his opinion, register his party preference, if any, serve as a delegate to party conventions, and cast his vote. This section also permits appointment, nomination, or election to nonpartisan public office in a local government unit. However, this section may not be construed as permitting an employee in the classified service or in those exempt positions named in sec. 110(3) of this chapter to take an active part in the management of a political party above the precinct level.

\* Sec. 2. This Act takes effect immediately in accordance with AS 01.10.070(c).
