AN ACT

Relating to authorizing the Department of Military Affairs to make expenditures to meet extraordinary expenditures and shortfalls in revenue of boroughs, cities, municipal utility systems and school districts incurred as a result of the natural disaster declared November 14, 1974; and providing for an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. The Department of Military Affairs is authorized to make expenditures of \$380,000 or such part as is necessary to carry out the provisions of this Act, to meet extraordinary expenditures and shortfalls in revenue of boroughs, cities, municipal utility systems and school districts in that area of the state declared a natural disaster area by President Ford's proclamation of November 14, 1974, where the extraordinary expenses and shortfalls in revenue were caused by the natural disaster.

* Sec. 2. No funds may be disbursed under this Act until the borough, city, municipal utility system or school district qualifying for the funds has applied to the department in the manner to be prescribed by the department. Boroughs, cities, municipal utility systems and school districts receiving funds under this Act shall account to the department for the expenditures of the funds.

* Sec. 3. No funds shall be approved for disbursement under this Act after June 30, 1976.

* Sec. 4. This Act takes effect immediately in accordance with AS 01.10.070(c).
