AN ACT

Authorizing special temporary state financial assistance to the Eagle River-Chugiak Borough; and providing for an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. LEGISLATIVE FINDING. Because of the pendency of litigation challenging the incorporation of the Eagle River-Chugiak Borough, the borough has been restricted in its ability to secure revenues for the organization and conduct of borough functions as contemplated under ch. 145, SLA 1974. This Act is directed at that special circumstance affecting the Eagle River-Chugiak Borough and is intended to provide temporary financial assistance enabling the borough to proceed with organization, planning and preparation to assume the powers of a second class borough.

* Sec. 2. FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE TO EAGLE RIVER-CHUGIAK BOROUGH. (a) Other provisions of law notwithstanding, the Department of Community and Regional Affairs may provide financial assistance to the Eagle River-Chugiak Borough enabling the borough to proceed with organization, planning and preparation to assume the powers of a second class borough, and for that purpose including but not limited to assistance with costs of general administration, legal and financial costs, and costs related to planning, platting and zoning functions.

(b) Payments under (a) of this section may be made under agreements entered into by the department and the Eagle River-Chugiak Borough, and other necessary parties, and providing terms, conditions and limitations which the commissioner of community and regional affairs considers necessary to carry out the purpose of this Act.

(c) No agreement encumbering money under this section may be made after June 30, 1975.

* Sec. 3. This Act takes effect immediately in accordance with AS 01.10.070(c).
