AN ACT

Relating to compensation for members of the Professional Teaching Practices Commission.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 14.20.440 is amended to read:

Sec. 14.20.440. REIMBURSEMENT. Members of the commission shall receive per diem according to law and are to be granted administrative leave with full pay by their employer for time spent in the performance of official duties under secs. 370 - 510 of this chapter. If a member is required to spend more than 15 days in a fiscal year in the performance of his official duties under secs. 370 - 510 of this chapter, the state shall reimburse the employer for costs incurred after the 15th day.
