## AN ACT

Relating to withholding tax; and providing for an effective date.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

\* Section 1. AS 43.20.170(a) is repealed and re-enacted to read:

(a) Every employer making payment of wages or salaries shall deduct and withhold an amount of tax computed in such a manner to approximate the amount of tax due on those wages under this chapter for that year. The department shall publish the rate of withholding required by this section which shall be expressed as a percentage of the amount required to be withheld under sec. 3402 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954. Every employer making a deduction and a withholding shall furnish to the employee upon request a record of the amount of tax withheld from the employee on a form prescribed by the department.

\* Sec. 2. This Act takes effect July 1, 1975.
