AN ACT

Relating to the restoration of teacher tenure rights on the removal or rehabilitation of a disability.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 14.20 is amended by adding a new section to read:

Sec. 14.20.165. RESTORATION OF TENURE RIGHTS. A teacher who held tenure rights and who was retired due to disability under AS 14.25.130, but whose disability (1) has been removed, and the removal of that disability is certified by a competent physician following a physical or mental examination, or (2) has been compensated for by rehabilitation or other appropriate restorative education or training, and that rehabilitation or restoration to health has been certified by the division of vocational rehabilitation of the Department of Education, shall be restored to full tenure rights in the district from which he was retired, at such time as an opening for which he is qualified becomes available.
