AN ACT

Relating to the publication of the names of juveniles for certain offenses; and changing Rule 26, Supreme Court Rules of Children's Procedure.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 47.10.090(b) is amended to read:

(b) The name or picture of a minor under the jurisdiction of the court may not be made public in connection with the minor's status as a delinquent or dependent child unless authorized by order of the court, except that the name of a minor who is found for the second time to have violated a law, which if committed by an adult would be a felony, shall be made public unless the court, for good cause, in certain individual cases, enters an order prohibiting the disclosure.

* Sec. 2. Section 1 of this Act changes Rule 26 of the Supreme Court Rules of Children's Procedure in that the rule now provides that the names and pictures of minors under the jurisdiction of the children's court are not to be made available to the public unless authorized by a court order which is accompanied by a written statement supporting the authorization, and sec. 1 provides that for a minor who is found for the second time to have violated a law, which if committed by an adult would be a felony, the minor's name must be made public unless the court, for good cause, in certain individual cases, enters an order prohibiting the disclosure.
