HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 21

Relating to the designation of an appropriate "gateway" to Chugach State Park.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS Chugach State Park is annually visited by hundreds of Alaskans and by innumerable visitors to Alaska; and

WHEREAS this park, located near the population center of the state, will attract more and more visitors as the years go by; and

WHEREAS it would appear to be only fitting that an appropriate approach be designated as an official entrance to the park; and

WHEREAS one logical location for such a gateway would be within the Chugiak-Eagle River area;

BE IT RESOLVED by the Alaska State Legislature that the Governor is respectfully requested to direct the Departments of Natural Resources and Highways, working in conjunction with the Governor's Office of Policy Development and Planning, to designate an appropriate approach within the Chugiak-Eagle River area as an official entrance to Chugach State Park.
