## HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 42

Commending Tom Fink, and expressing regret that he has resigned as a member of the Ninth Alaska Legislature.

### BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS Tom Fink was elected to the Alaska Legislature in 1966; and
