SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 12

Relating to a road between Bethel and Napakiak.

BE IT RESOLVED

BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS a road between Bethel and Napakiak would provide year-round ground transportation for Oscarville and Napakiak as well as for Bethel; and

WHEREAS the construction of such a road would provide an alternative to the Bethel harbor and dock facility which is difficult to service during dry years because of down-river sand bars; and

WHEREAS the road would promote the general welfare of many villagers; and

WHEREAS the construction of the road would make available land for commercial and residential development on ground that is high and well out of the range of flood waters; and

WHEREAS construction of this proposed road would cost very little and would additionally obviate the need for a proposed airport in the Oscarville area;

BE IT RESOLVED by the Alaska State Legislature that it respectfully requests the Governor to direct the Department of Highways to undertake immediately a feasibility study for the construction of a road between Bethel and Napakiak.
