SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 4

Commending Colonel M. E. Dankworth.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS Colonel M. E. Dankworth, director of the Alaska State Troopers, has announced his retirement, effective February 16, 1975; and
