## SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 9

Relating to air carrier service in certain areas of the state.

### BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS transportation is one of the most desperately needed things in many Alaskan communities; and

WHEREAS many Alaskan communities have no means of transportation of people or goods except as can be handled by air carriers; and

WHEREAS existing air carrier service to the communities that most depend on that mode of transportation is often inadequate to handle the requirements of the people; and

WHEREAS Senator Stevens has announced that he intends to ask Congress to enact legislation which would permit two air carriers to service any Alaskan community that has air service as its only means of transporting goods and people; and

WHEREAS, if such legislation were enacted, its potential favorable impact for thousands of Alaskans would be tremendous;

BE IT RESOLVED by the Alaska State Legislature that it wholeheartedly endorses the proposed legislation by Senator Stevens and urges the United States Congress to enact such legislation at the earliest possible time.
