AN ACT

Relating to wage claims; and providing for an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 23.05.140(b) is amended to read:

(b) If the employment is terminated, regardless of the cause of termination, all wages, salaries or other compensation for labor or services become due immediately and shall be paid within three working days after the termination at the place where the employee is usually paid or at a location agreed upon by the employer and employee.

* Sec. 2. AS 23.05.140 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

(d) If an employer violates (b) of this section by failing to pay within three working days of termination, he is liable to the employee for payment of the employee's regular wage, salary or other compensation from the time of demand to the time of payment, or for 90 working days, whichever is the lesser amount.

* Sec. 3. AS 23.05.220(c) is amended to read:

(c) The department may not accept an assignment of a claim in excess of \$5,000.

* Sec. 4. This Act takes effect immediately in accordance with AS 01.10.070(c).
