AN ACT

Relating to the design of license plates.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 28.10.130 is amended by adding new subsections to read:

(b) After January 1, 1979, passenger vehicle plates provided in (a) of this section shall be fully reflective and display along with the Alaska flag the traditional colors of yellow-gold and blue.

(c) The commissioner of public safety shall sponsor a contest to select the slogan for the passenger vehicle permanent registration plates among Alaska's school children in grades 7 through 12 and shall select the slogan that best represents Alaska's history and hopes for the future. The commissioner shall reward the winner with a scholarship in the amount of \$500.

(d) The department may not adopt a new or altered design for the main plate under this section unless it substantially embodies the design selected by the commissioner under this Act.
