AN ACT

Relating to dress codes and appearance standards of state employees; and providing for an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 39.26 is amended by adding a new section to read:

Sec. 39.26.015. DRESS CODES AND APPEARANCE STANDARDS. Dress codes and appearance standards adopted by a department, division, agency, official, or other employee of the state, which are to be applied to state employees shall be in the form of a regulation subject to legislative review under the Administrative Procedure Act (AS 44.62).

* Sec. 2. AS 39.26.020 is amended to read:

Sec. 39.26.020. APPLICATION OF PROVISIONS. The provisions of secs. 10 and 15 of this chapter apply to those state employees in the classified and partially exempt services.

* Sec. 3. This Act takes effect immediately in accordance with AS 01.10.070(c).
