AN ACT

Relating to survivor benefits under the public employees' retirement system; and providing for an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 39.35.680(19) is amended to read:

(19) "surviving spouse" means the spouse of an employee who has been married to the employee for at least one year and who, at the time of the employee's death, was living with the employee or dependent upon the employee for support, or living apart for justifiable cause or by reason of desertion by the employee; the one-year marriage requirement does not apply to cases where the employee's death was an occupational or accidental death;

* Sec. 2. This Act is retroactive to January 1, 1976.

* Sec. 3. This Act takes effect immediately in accordance with AS 01.10.070(c).
