## AN ACT

Relating to teacher certificates; and providing for an effective date.

---

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

\* Section 1. AS 14.20.010 is amended to read:

Sec. 14.20.010. TEACHER CERTIFICATE REQUIRED. A person may not be employed as a teacher in the public schools of the state unless he possesses a valid teacher certificate except that a person who has made application to the department for a teacher certificate or renewal of a teacher certificate which has not been acted upon by the department may be employed as a teacher in the public schools of the state until the department has taken action on the application, but in no case may employment without a certificate last longer than three months.

\* Sec. 2. This Act takes effect July 1, 1976.
