AN ACT

Relating to the Joint Federal-State Land Use Planning Commission.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 41.40.030(b) is amended to read:

(b) Until June 30, 1979, at least one member appointed by the governor shall be a Native of Alaska who is eligible for enrollment under the Alaska Native Claims Settlement Act, P.L. 92-203, 85 Stat. 688.

* Sec. 2. AS 41.40.060(b) is amended to read:

(b) On or before May 30, 1976, the commission shall submit a report to the President of the United States, the Congress, the governor and legislature with respect to its planning and other activities under this chapter, together with its recommendations for programs or other actions which it determines should be taken by the United States and the state. The commission shall submit its final, comprehensive report on or before June 30, 1979.

* Sec. 3. AS 41.40.070 is amended to read:

Sec. 41.40.070. TERMINATION OF THE COMMISSION. The commission ceases to exist on June 30, 1979.

* Sec. 4. AS 41.40.120 is amended to read:

Sec. 41.40.120. RECOMMENDATIONS BY THE COMMISSION. The director of the division of lands retains the authority to make and revise classifications of land under the authority of AS 38.05.300. However, any recommendation made by the commission and concurred in by the governor or his designate on the commission as to the most wise and benefi-

official use of state land constitutes to that extent an establishment for the state of the use of that land until June 30, 1979 and thereafter until changed pursuant to law. The commission may by the same process reconsider and make new recommendations until June 30, 1979 when it is in the public interest.
