AN ACT

Relating to fees for fish and small game licenses for military personnel; and providing for an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 16.05.340 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

(d) Members of the military service on active duty who are permanently stationed in the state, and their dependents, who do not qualify as residents under sec. 940(14) of this chapter, may obtain special nonresident military small game and sport fishing licenses at the rates for resident hunting and sport fishing licenses, but may not take a big game animal without previously purchasing a regular nonresident hunting license and a numbered, nontransferable appropriate tag, issued at the nonresident rate, under (a)(16) of this section.

* Sec. 2. This Act takes effect January 1, 1977.
