AN ACT

Relating to operator licenses and school bus driver permits.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 28.15 is amended by adding a new section to read:

Sec. 28.15.015. MEDICAL EXAMINATIONS. A requirement for a medical examination as a condition precedent to obtaining an operator's license or school bus driver's permit shall be satisfied if the applicant is the holder of a current and valid first- or second-class medical certificate issued under the federal aviation regulations and has passed any requirement of the Department of Education relating to tests for tuberculosis.
